

MY FAMILY LOVES GIRL SCOUTS **Patch Program**

Purpose: To encourage adult involvement in troop activities
For: Daisy, Brownie, Junior, Teen (Cadette & Senior) Girl Scouts

REQUIREMENTS:

A girl must have at least one adult family member or friend perform a service to the troop on at least 4 occasions during the course of one registration year (October 1 to September 30). **The amount of time and effort put forth by the troop leader, assistant troop leader and troop product sale manager would automatically qualify their daughters for this patch.** Troop Product Sale Manager and any adult handling money must be registered. Troop Committee Members are encouraged to register. Family supports product sales – girl meets minimum participation requirements.

POSSIBLE SERVICE ACTIVITIES WOULD INCLUDE:

1. Provide transportation for troop outings
2. Help with troop telephoning
3. Assist with troop projects or activities
4. Share a skill, talent, or hobby with troop or Service Unit
5. Care for the leader's children during training or troop functions
6. Assist with paperwork or record keeping
7. Locate resource people for troop program
8. Accompany the troop on an outdoor activity (campout, cookout, hike)
9. Accompany the troop to Service Unit or Council events
10. Hold a position on the Service Unit's service team
11. Add your own idea

Requirements for successive years are the same as above.

Two adults with one child may share the needed four activities (e.g. each adult could perform 2 services and this would count as 4).

If an adult has more than one girl in Girl Scouting, any four services will entitle all sibling Girl Scouts to receive the patch. The services may benefit one or all of the troops involved.

During the first year of participation a girl will be awarded a patch. A girl continuing with the program in future years will receive bars to add to her patch.
