SISTER TROOP/GROUP PATCH

THE SISTER TROOP/GROUP PATCH IS A GREAT OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE NEW FRIENDS AND SHARE YOUR SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE WITH YOUNGER GIRLS. THE PURPOSE OF THE PATCH IS TO HELP YOUNGER GIRLS LEARN ABOUT THE NEXT LEVEL IN GIRL SCOUTING SO THAT THEY WILL BE INTERESTED IN CONTINUING IN THE GIRL MOVEMENT.

THE PATCH IS EARNED BY AN ENTIRE TROOP/GROUP; NOT BY AN INDIVIDUAL. ANY BROWNIE, JUNIOR, CADETTE OR SENIOR GIRL SCOUT TROOP/GROUP CAN EARN THE PATCH. ALL MEMBERS RECEIVE A PATCH EVEN IF THEY DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN EVERY ACTIVITY.

ACTIVITY INFORMATION

1. ACTIVITIES SHOULD BE CARRIED OUT OVER THE TROOP/GROUP YEAR.
2. THE ENTIRE TROOP/GROUP SHOULD BE INVOLVED.
3. THE TROOP/GROUP SHOULD WORK WITH ONE SISTER TROOP/GROUP TO COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES AND TO EARN THE PATCH.
4. THE SISTER TROOP/GROUP CAN BE FROM YOUR OWN COMMUNITY OR A DIFFERENT ONE. TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THE DIERSE MEMBERSHIP OF OUR COUNCIL, WE SUGGEST THAT YOU WORK WITH A SISTER TROOP/GROUP OUTSIDE OF YOUR COMMUNITY. CONTACT YOUR MEMBERSHIP SPECIALIST IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE IN LOCATING A SISTER TROOP/GROUP.
5. THE SISTER TROOP/GROUP SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN PLANNING AND CARRYING OUT AT LEAST ONE OF THE ACTIVITIES.
6. AT ONE OF THE ACTIVITIES, THE NEXT LEVEL GIRL SCOUT PROGRAM SHOULD BE INTRODUCED TO THE YOUNGER GIRLS.
7. THE ACTIVITIES SHOULD BE VARIED.
8. APPROPRIATE SISTER TROOP/GROUP LEVELS:
BROWNIE GIRL SCOUTS TO DAISY GIRL SCOUTS
(OR PROSPECTIVE BROWNIE GIRL SCOUTS)
JUNIOR GIRL SCOUTS TO BROWNIE GIRL SCOUTS
CADETTE GIRL SCOUTS TO JUNIOR GIRL SCOUTS
SENIOR GIRL SCOUTS TO CADETTE GIRL SCOUTS
9. YOU SHOULD HOSTESS AT LEAST THREE ACTIVITIES

ACTIVITIES CAN BE ANY EVENT, TRIP, SERVICE PROJECT, MEETING, ETC. IN WHICH THE SISTER TROOP/GROUP CAN PARTICIPATE.
