Rookie Leader Award	troop/group leader, asst leader	the first year leader who has made the most significant contribution to the SU	SU nomination form plus 2 SU team signatures	1
Soaring High	an adult volunteer member	making multiple commitments to the SU, completing all required training, has not received Soaring High before	SU nomination form plus 2 SU team signatures	1 for every 10 troops
Outstanding Volunteer	an adult volunteer member	benefiting the SU in a way that is beyond the expectations of the positions & completing training	SU nomination form plus one letter	very prestigious-minimal amount
